On the water



Rotorua has always drawn people with an adventurous spirit, and people looking for adrenalin-pumping action can't go past this region. Rotorua boasts an awesome selection of activities guaranteed to get even the bravest visitor's heart racing.

Sledge over white-water rapids or raft the world's highest commercially rafted waterfall. Hang on tight for 360 degree jet boat spins or race around any of Rotorua's lakes on water skis, a ski biscuit,

wakeboard or banana boat. Squeeze and splash your way through a narrow canyon to a thermal pool followed by a thrilling jet boat ride on New Zealand's longest river.



Thrills and spills...

On land

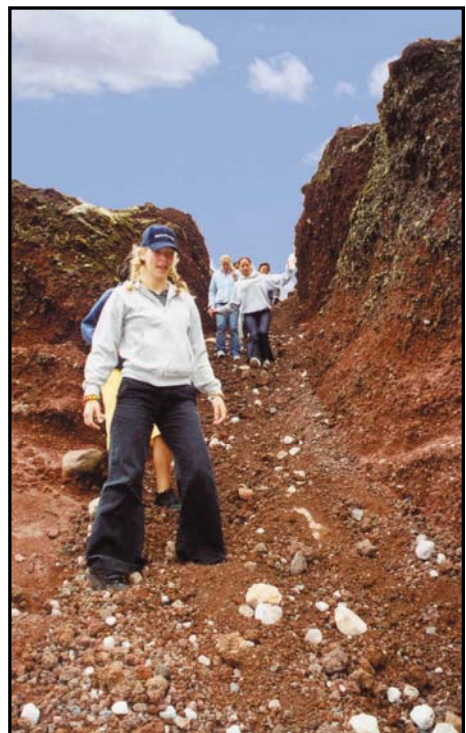
Test your driving skills with an off road safari or hold on for dear life on a monster truck tour. Run, slip or slide down the slopes of an extinct volcano, speed along luge tracks down a mountain, throw yourself from a bungy tower.

Mountain biking is huge in Rotorua. Take up the challenge and enjoy one of the many scenic mountain bike tracks and trails in Whakarewarewa or Whirinaki Forests.



Tumble head over heels down a hillside in the revolutionary Zorb, or ride over rugged land on horseback, farm bike, or in a four-wheel drive.

Mysterious Mt Tarawera is a dormant volcano and one of Rotorua's most recognisable landmarks. Bump your way to the summit in a 4WD, followed by a scree slide into the crater and a death-defying mountain bike down the 1111m slope. Not for the faint-hearted.



Getting high...

From the air



Jumping from a plane is a once-in-a-lifetime experience, and could be the scariest thing you'll ever do, but floating downwards from 15,000 feet gives you an outlook over Rotorua you wouldn't get any other way.

Bungy jumping is also a thrill like no other. Try the 43m-high Rotorua Bungy, which sends jumpers hurtling towards the trout-filled Ngongotaha Stream. Jumpers – if they remember to look – can enjoy spectacular views of Lake Rotorua and Mokoia Island. Single and tandem jumps are available.

See the city from the air with a helicopter or floatplane trip.

Whether it is a little taste you are after, or an adventure-filled break, Rotorua doesn't do boring.
