YOUR THINK SAFE CHECKLIST

Protecting your belongings

- Lock all windows & doors at night & when leaving accommodation
- Do not leave valuable items in your vehicle or accommodation
- Keep important items out of sight in your vehicle/accommodation
- Keep photocopies of all your important documents
- Lock your vehicle when visiting attractions
- Do not leave your bags unattended
- Do not carry large amounts of cash

Travelling tips:

- Drive on the left - hand side of the road
- Drive with extra care on windy, unsealed or icy roads
- Everyone in your vehicle must wear a safety belt
- Wear life jackets and carry extra fuel when boating
- When tramping/hiking let someone know where you are going and when you are due back
